



## Research Report on a Technological Design Related Career

Taking a course in Technology Design is a great way to sample what you may experience in the Engineering field. Select a related career field that you may be interested in and research it to present in the form of a presentation, 13 to 15 slides in length. The presentation must show titles and key information in different forms such as text, charts, maps, illustrations, and/or images. Text points should be 50-60 % of slide while images and/or charts should be no more than 40-50% of slide. See website for resources, details, and steps to complete this project.



Your researched career field will require you to look up some common areas of information which will help all decide if it is something you are interested in along with all the details. The following \* key information is to be included in your career rough report and presentation, in the following order:

- Job title, general description (2), responsibilities (2), and salary/wages (2)
- Related skills (2), interests (2), and values (2)
- Schooling (2), preparation (2), and requirements (2) (Association)
- Future forecast/outlook of field area (2)
- Your resources and where to go for further support (-5 if not included)

There are several resources on Mr. Franzen's site including samples and templates. For your presentation application software, Google Slides is the most practical, allowing you the most flexibility and speaker notes, although Microsoft PowerPoint, Prezi, or similar are also other options.

### Evaluation

Once done, give yourself a mark and have a partner review and peer mark your report and enter marks in the table below. Ensure this is handed in the same or next day after you present as you will be getting marks on the rough report, your presentation material, presentation being presented, self and peer evaluations.
