Research Report on a Construction Related Career

Taking a course in construction is a great way to sample what you may experience in the field. Part of this course is learning about construction related careers. This assignment is designed to allow you to pick a related career, that you may be interested in and research it, to find out what it is all about and share with the rest of the class.

Your researched career field will require you to look up some common areas of information which will help all decide if it is something you are interested in along with all the details. The following * key information is to be included in your one-to-two page (maximum) career report in no particular order:

- Job title, general description, responsibilities, and salary/wages
- Related skills, interests and values
- Schooling, preparation and requirements
- Future forecast/outlook of field area
- Your resources and where to go for further support
